## **Further Information**

- Vending Machines will provide a selection of sandwiches, snacks, fruits, warm- & cold beverages. This enables our students to satisfy their hunger and thirst during the off buffet hours.
- Our menu plan rarely contains pork dishes every 4 weeks **one** of the 3 dishes may contain pork but this is clearly marked.

## PK to grade 1 will never be served any pork dishes!

- Our menus can be bought individually as well you do not have to participate in our program but with a participation, a price deduction will be granted.
- Additional to the 3 Menu Lines we offer a daily changing Pasta dish and occasionally a Special of the Day (= a selection of interesting special dishes).
- On regular basis a Sushi Chef offers Sushi & Maki dishes available for MS- & HS students
- On regular basis a Kebab Chef offers Chicken Kebab available for MS-HS students
- Salad plays an important role in our culinary choices. At the Salad Bar our guests can choose between at least 6 different fresh salads, a choice of dressings and grains.
- We offer daily a fine selection of freshly made Sandwiches (mainly whole grain)
- Our healthy, homemade Snacks such as sandwiches, yogurts, vegetable sticks, wraps, vital shakes and fruit cups are always offered.
- In the display cases a large selection of Mineral Waters, Fruit Juices, Yoghurt-, Milk- & Whey Beverages are provided.
- Carbonated Beverages with high sugar content are not offered!
- At the Coffee Shop we offer a great healthy variety of different foods, snacks & Beverages





## Prepaid school lunch program

SV Group Austria offers and administrates the AIS "**Prepaid school lunch program**" which is provided successfully for many years at the AIS.

The AIS "Prepaid school lunch program" means that, if registered, your child will daily be provided with a fresh, on site prepared, warm, delicious menu made of the best seasonal and regional ingredients possible.

There are several options to choose from - everything depending on which grade your son / daughter is in - and depending on which option you choose. SV Group Austria is granting you a price deduction of 3 - 5 % on the regular menu price depending on your payment decision.

All our menus contain of soup, salad, and main course.

Instead of the warm menu you can choose every food except Icecream.

Please notice that icecream and all beverages (except mineral water) are NOT included in the prepaid program and are billed without exception to the Gold Card Account.

Set ahead, that there is money booked on the Gold Card.

Please notice: The Gold Card is a Pay Card and allows no overdraft.

#### **Grade PK to KG**

Our "little ones" are provided with set hot organic meals (clearly marked on our menuplan - which can be found on the AIS homepage). They will be delivered to the classroom during lunchtime.

#### Grade 1

Our "little ones" are provided with set hot organic menu or cold organic menu, which will be delivered to the cafeteria at lunchtime. Every two weeks, parents will receive the menu via mail and are asked to choose the favorite lunch for their child.

#### Grade 2 to Grade 3

The students have the option to choose from all dishes on our menu plan or choose the cold menu option (take 2 items out of sandwiches, yoghurt or fruit – soup or small salad is always included).

#### **Grade 4 to Grade 5**

The students have the option to choose from all dishes on our menu plan. In addition these age groups are offered a "pasta of the day" and "special of the day" - a total of 5 warm dishes to choose from every day.

The Cold menu option is available for them too

#### Grade 6 to Grade 12

Starting with Grade 6 we offer our students an even wider lunch selection - a large variety of freshly made interesting sandwiches, various fruit salads and other suitable and enjoyable snacks are offered. All Beverages are available at any time.

As a very special offer for High School Students we open the café during their break for a daily "Fast Dish".





## **Additional Costs**

As stated above, with "Prepaid school lunch program" your son / daughter will get a warm school lunch every day.

Regardless of the prepaid program additional costs can occur.

For example:

KG – Grade 1: If your child is not registered in the Milk Program and orders milk or cacao via online menu, additional costs will occur.

Grade 2 & 3: If your child is not registered in the Milk Program and takes milk or cacao from the buffet, additional costs will occur.

Grade 4 & 5: Through the monthly Ice Cream Day on the first school day of the month.

Grade 6 – 12: Through all Consumptions which are not covered by the prepaid program.

The costs for this Special Day Offerings or additional Items are charged to your son / daughter's Gold Card account. Please assure that there is enough money on the Gold Card Account, if you want your child to participate on the additional services. If your Card Balance does not cover the purchase we are not able to sell you the goods. There is no overdraft possible on the Gold Card.

Please be assured, that we will work with devotion, professionalism and joy to provide a nutritious, healthy diet and an appropriate offer. We appreciate and welcome inputs and suggestions from the AIS community. We therefore invite everyone who has ideas and / or suggestions to contact us. We will incorporate them as possible.
