CURRICULUM

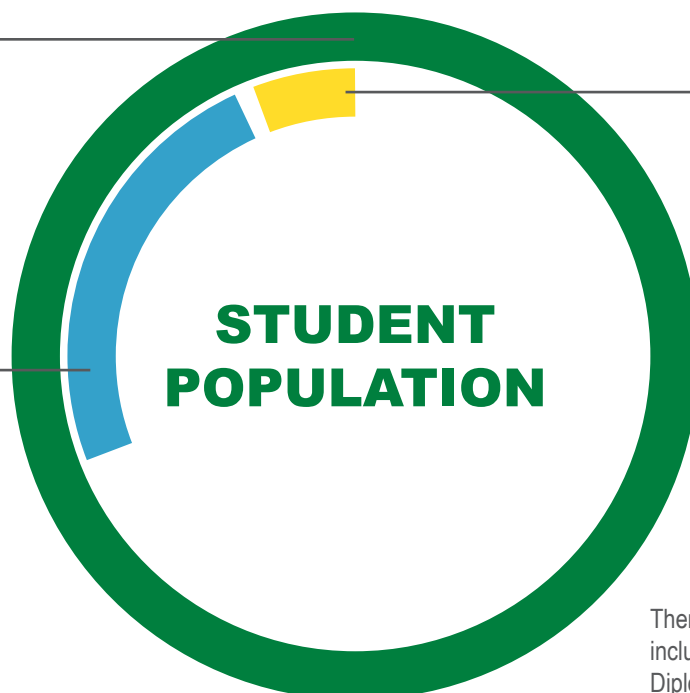

TRANSCRIPT INFORMATION

The GPA calculation is based on a four point scale. All courses are calculated in the GPA except those graded on a Pass/Fail basis. International Baccalaureate (IB) and Advanced Placement (AP) courses are awarded an additional 0.33 in the GPA calculation. Language courses at the Intermediate B and C levels are weighted.

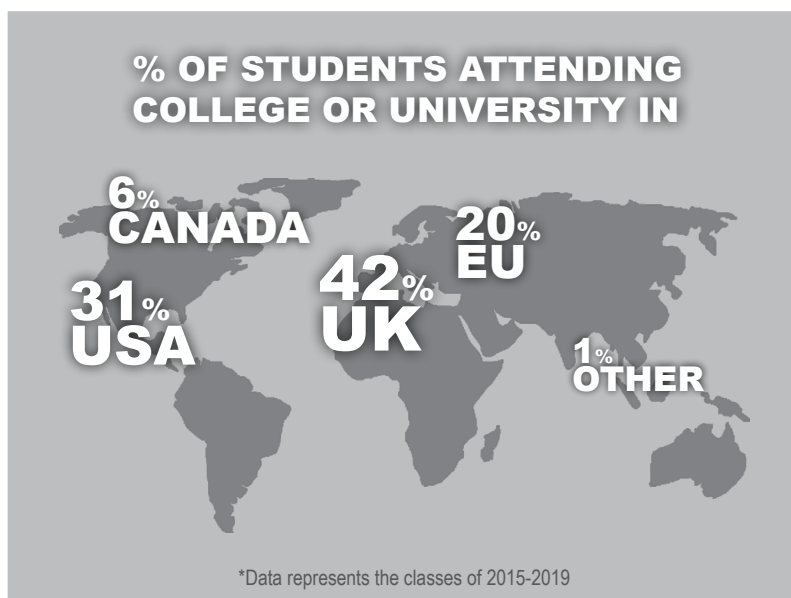

Classes are seventy-five to eighty minutes in length and meet on an eight-day rotation. There are four academic periods per day and students take a maximum of eight courses per semester. (Some IB courses meet additional times during the week.) One credit is earned per full-year course; one half-credit is earned per half-year course.

The marks awarded for each course range from 7 (highest) to 1 (lowest).

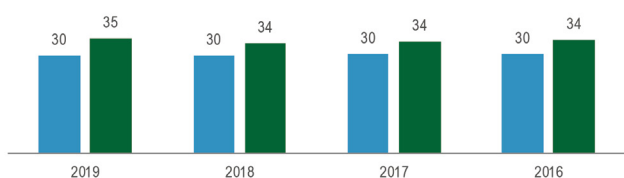

We ask that all higher education institutions take this into account when evaluating our students' applications.
