In the list below some of the courses that A.I.S. parents tried:

- Berlitz - www.berlitz.at - +43 1 512 82 86 has 3 schools in Vienna (Graben, Mariahilferstrasse and Florisdorf) and offers individual or group training for German and many other languages. It is not cheap, but it is well structured.
- Sprachenzentrum within the Vienna University Campus. www.sprachenzentrum.univie.ac.at. There are courses of varying intensity, at various times of day with international participants. Placement tests (about 30 min) are compulsory for new participants, unless they are beginner students at the A1/1 level or they can provide a ÖSD or Goethe certificate.
- Deutsche Akademie, <https://www.deutschakademie.com/learn-german-courses/> is in a central position, very close to the Opera House. The school offers courses at all levels lasting 4 weeks, 3 hours/day, from Monday to Thursday. The commitment required is intense, but their effectiveness depends a lot on the teacher's qualification and ability.
- Learn Personal <http://www.learn-personal.com/> offers group and individual classes also on the weekend. Intensive courses are possible here.
- Die Wiener Volkshochschulen www.vhs.at offers courses at every level at very convenient prices in many different districts of Vienna
